Thank you for showing interest in Elvin Acting's weekly "Intermediate and Advanced Acting" workshops.

We will be meeting Tuesday evenings between **January 12th 2016 and April 19th 2016**. All the available dates are noted on the attached "Workshop Booking Form"

Each week we will be moving from one topic to the next, introducing new skills and enhancing what you may have already learnt. The topics have been arranged to flow as an intensive course for those wishing to attend the whole term, but understanding pressures of committing to 15 classes, there are alternative options available for those wishing to partake in specific sections of the course.
